AUDIENCE QUESTIONS AND COMMENTS ON AGENDA ITEMS 32 33 34 There were no audience questions or comments on agenda items. 35 36 37 3. BUSINESS ITEMS 38 A. Discussion with LMP 39 Richard Wilbert with LMP said they had marked 25 of the dead pine trees. There was a question 40

regarding the damage to the fence. Ms. Hicks said that because there is no way to determine when or exactly how the damage occurred, LMP is willing to split the cost to repair the fence with the CDD. Discussion followed. Supervisor Barbour asked if the mulch by the pool heater is a fire hazard. Scott Carlson with LMP said he has never had an issue on any other sites. Supervisor Barbour said he would like a proposal to put stone in this area. Supervisor Oliver asked about the contract having another community's name. Mr. Carlson said that it was a typo and they can cross it out and initial. There was some discussion on tree removal. Mr. Carlson said it is not included in the

contract because of the costs to remove the trees. They also have to use a certified arborist. Supervisor Dowd asked about the proposal they were already given. A discussion followed about the dead pine trees in the community. Mr. Carlson said they need to be removed before more damage occurs. Ms. Hicks asked about the cost per tree. Mr. Carlson said \$110 per tree. The Board discussed it further.

Supervisor Wickens said the response to the question regarding the funding from Neal and money owed to Water's Edge was not adequate. She would like a more thorough answer. She also felt that pages 27-28 from the Audit regarding the transfer of funds do not provide enough information; she would like more details about the transfer of funds. She wanted to know which conditions were not met from page 29.

The proposal to repair the pool heater was also discussed. Supervisor Barbour said they need to clean and change the roll out sensors. If that doesn't work, the Board wanted to allow Supervisor Wickens to approve the lowest bid for repair.
